	 IMPORTANT: To prepare for your colonoscopy, purchase the following at your pharmacy: 2 Dulcolax (Laxative) Tablets – no prescription needed Miralax Laxative Powder 8.3 oz. bottle Gatorade, Powerade or Gatorade-Zero (Qty. 2 of the 32 oz. bottle) **If diabetic, purchase the Gatorade-Zero only. No Red
PREP	FOR PROCEDURE:
1)	On, the day before your colonoscopy, you may consume a light breakfast before 9 am. Make sure it is a <u>LOW FIBER</u> breakfast consisting of foods like eggs, toast/bread, turkey breast lunch meat or chicken breast lunch meat and saltine crackers.
2)	At 9:00 am, YOU MUST STOP ALL SOLID FOODS AND START THE CLEAR LIQUID DIET: Clear liquids include Broths: Chicken, Vegetable or Beef, Coffee with or without sweeteners but no milk or creamers, Tea sweet or unsweet, Clear Soft Drinks, Gatorade/Powerade, White Grape Juice or Apple Juice without pulp, Jell-O, Popsicles without fruit or yogurt & Lemonade. ***NO RED LIQUIDS, JELLO or POPSICLES***
3)	Take regular medication the day prior to procedure. Take only heart or blood pressure medicine with a sip of water the morning of your procedure. **IF ON ASPIRIN, BLOOD THINNERS, OR ON ANY WEIGHT LOSS/DIABETES MEDICATION, CHECK WITH YOUR PRESCRIBING DOCTOR ON WHEN TO STOP. **
4)	At 3:00 pm, take 1 Dulcolax tablets with 8oz of water.
5)	At 4:00 pm, mix bottle 4 oz. bottle of Miralax powder in a pitcher with (1) 32 oz. bottles of Gatorade. Drink the Miralax mixture of Gatorade over the next 2 hours.
6)	At 7:00 pm, take 1 Dulcolax tablets with 8oz of water.
7)	The morning of your procedure at, mix bottle 4 oz. bottle of Miralax powder in a pitcher with (1) 32 oz. bottles of Gatorade. Drink the Miralax mixture of Gatorade over the next 2 hours. Do not drink any liquids after your last dose of bowel prep.
